Mother 1 do not no when she expects to return whether at all or not I am boarding at the bearding House or we are takeing meals there and sleeping at home Lillian is at work in the mill and Jessie is looking after the children 1 am going to try it for awhile as the children can not keep the house as they should. I tell you it is somthing else to be in the condition that I am I have thought of marrying again but you know that would no dought cause trouble as I certianly would not agree for any woman to mistreat the children.
