What experience we have had in the past with service such as you refer to has not proven very satisfactory, and we have dealt with two different companies. We have felt that operatives of this kind, - i. e., those who are sent out for this purpose, really have a tendency to stir up strife and give unnecessary trouble from that standpoint, feeling that their job depends on trouble always brewing. Our conclusion may be wrong as regards all companies, but we naturally have to profit by our past experience.

If you feel like making a proposition covering yearly service we would like to hear from you; in fact it would appear from your letter that that would be the only way to do it successfully.
