Friday Oct. 30, 1914.

Reported for ~~work~~ at 6:30 A.M.

Received letter at General Delivery with orders to report to the Supt. if the Boss would not transfer me. I reported at 12:45 and was told to go over to Mill #1 if I wanted to. I went over there and was told to come back Monday morning.

The strikers are to hold a mass meeting on Sunday, and the leading Textile leaders of the Country are to be there to address them. I was out with several of the boys from the Mill last night and there was nothing said about the union, except that none of them would think of joining.

There were several of the men who are out on strike who were around trying to borrow money from some of the men who are now working in the Mill
