MEMORANDA:

May 4, 1915

No. 16 called me by 'phone this afternoon about 3:30 and stated that Mrs. Conboy gave all of them notice that the strike was called off and that Camps would have all tents meanwrement by next Sunday week. In the meanwhile they should look about for positions, as they would not be housed after that time. A few of the ring-leaders would be prevailed upon to stay here and live in two or three of the boarding houses so as to proselyte to the Union ranks any of our workers that appears possible.

It, therefore, will be necessary that we maintain No. 16 in the outside position for some time, to keep track of these special men and counteract any efforts they make.
