June 25, 1915 -OE-5

This evening late, No. 16 reported in person at our office and explained that Mrs. Maddox, the daughter of Coogler, Probation Officer, living on Kirkwood Ave, a Mr. Scarborough, a preacher at Newman, Ga., and a Mrs. McDade, were to address a meeting that night at the location of the old Presbyterian church, near the foot of Virgil St., on Ashland St.

They made an effigy of Governor Slaton, which they intended to burn, and drag through the streets.

He also reported that a lawyer by the name of Hillyer was instrumental in creating a great deal of trouble among the College Park and Hapeville people.
