I reported at the mill this morning @ 15 A.M.

In #1 mill #3 room I tried to finish fixing my looms so they would run better this morning before starting time. on one loom there was a buckle that interfered with setting the harness right, and I ask the loom fixer to take off same, he said have you been fooling with it, I said yes, he said fix it your self. Lamer!

The loom stood a little while before he taken the buckle off. but he didnt set the harness so the selvage would run, and I ask <sup>him</sup> why he didnt fix same. he only said keep your hands off the loom, and worked on the loom again but didnt do it any good. I said if you can fix looms I dont see why you dont fix that loom, he said if you know so much about it, fix it your self. The said loom stood over one hour before I had time to fix same.

this morning windows all closed  
it was 80 wet & 4 dry and my work  
which is the 14 SW run very good  
but later several windows were  
opened and it was 88 dry & 4 wet  
and my work run very bad but  
kept the looms going by speeding  
up
